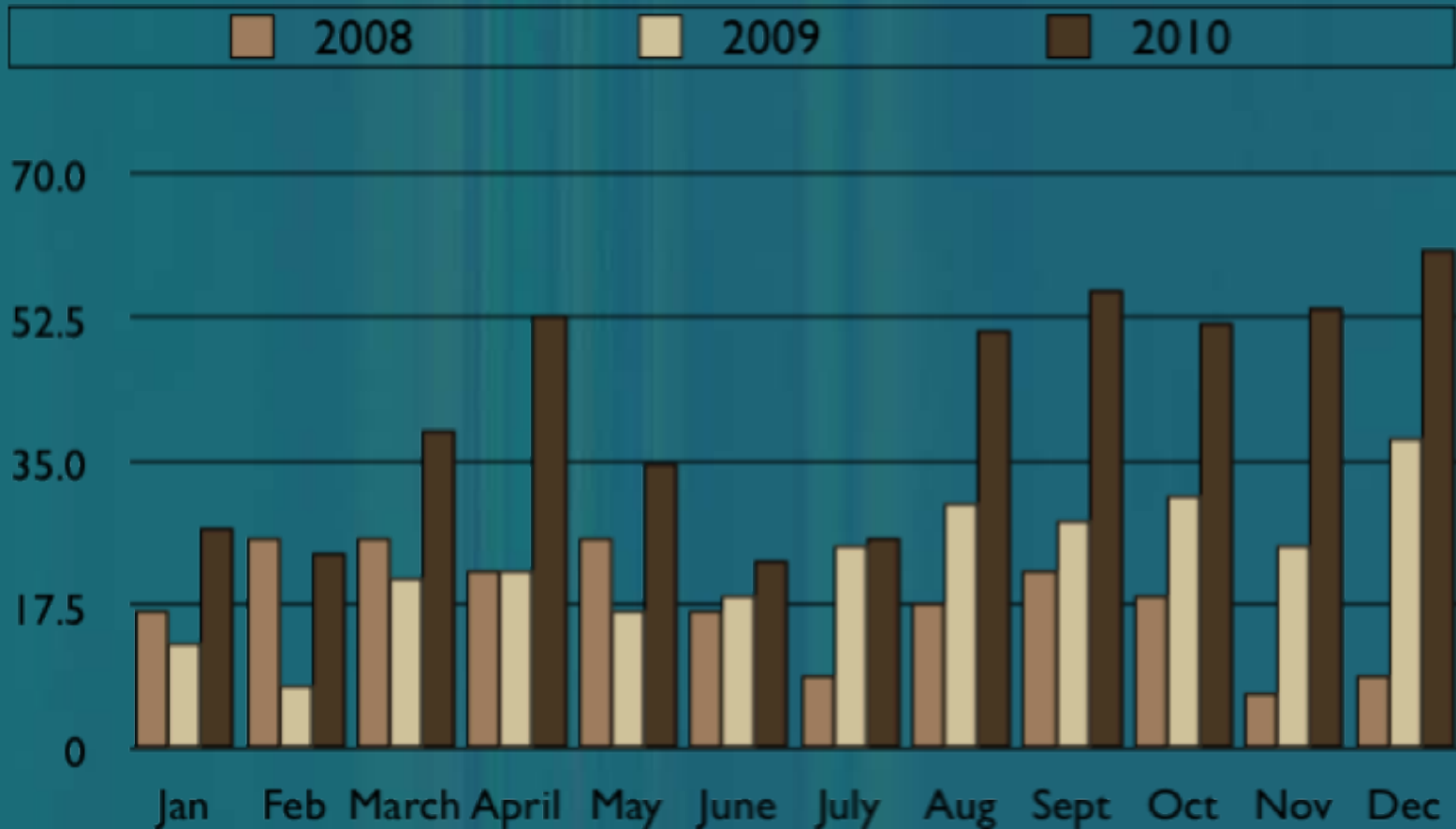

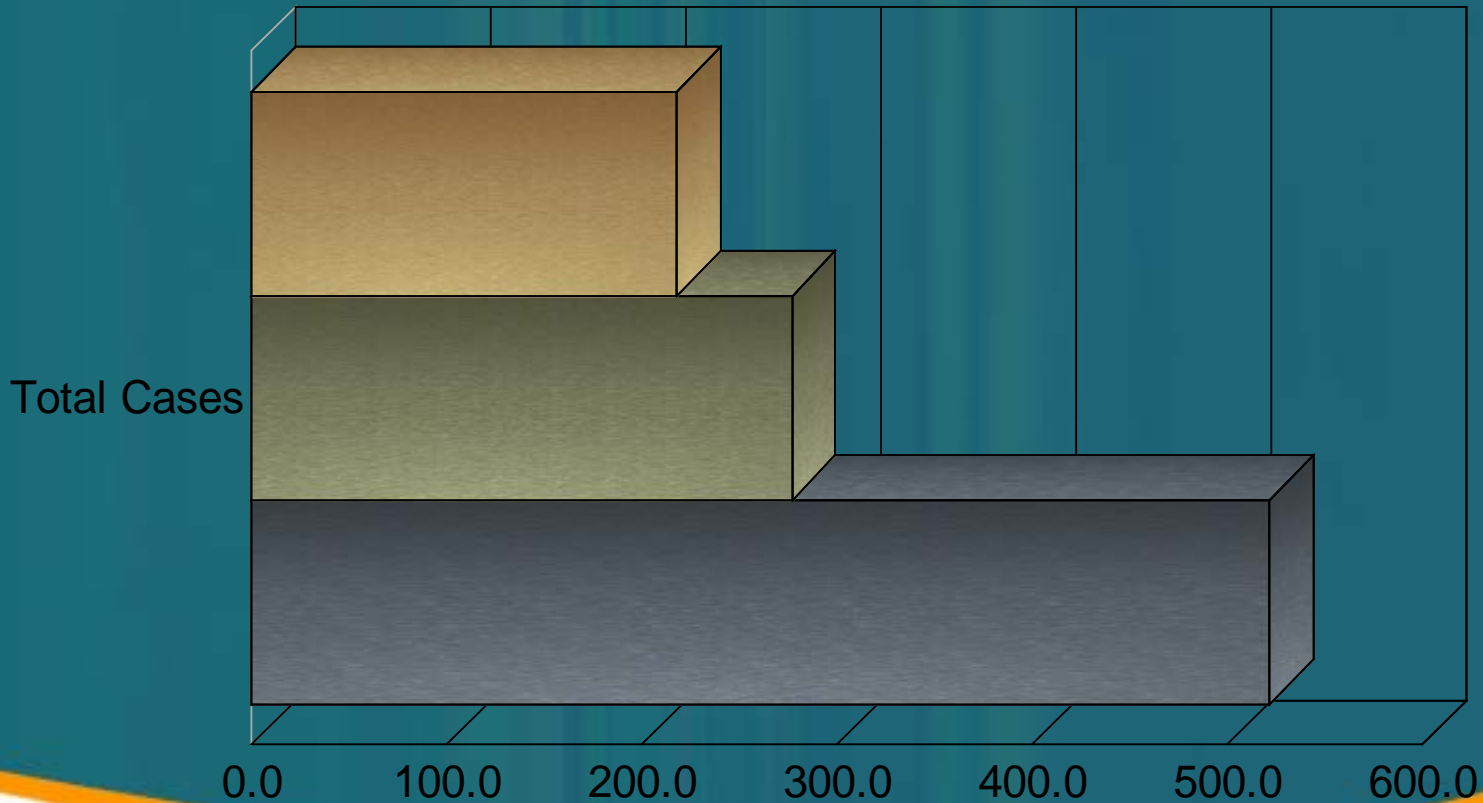

AZ Pertussis Statistics



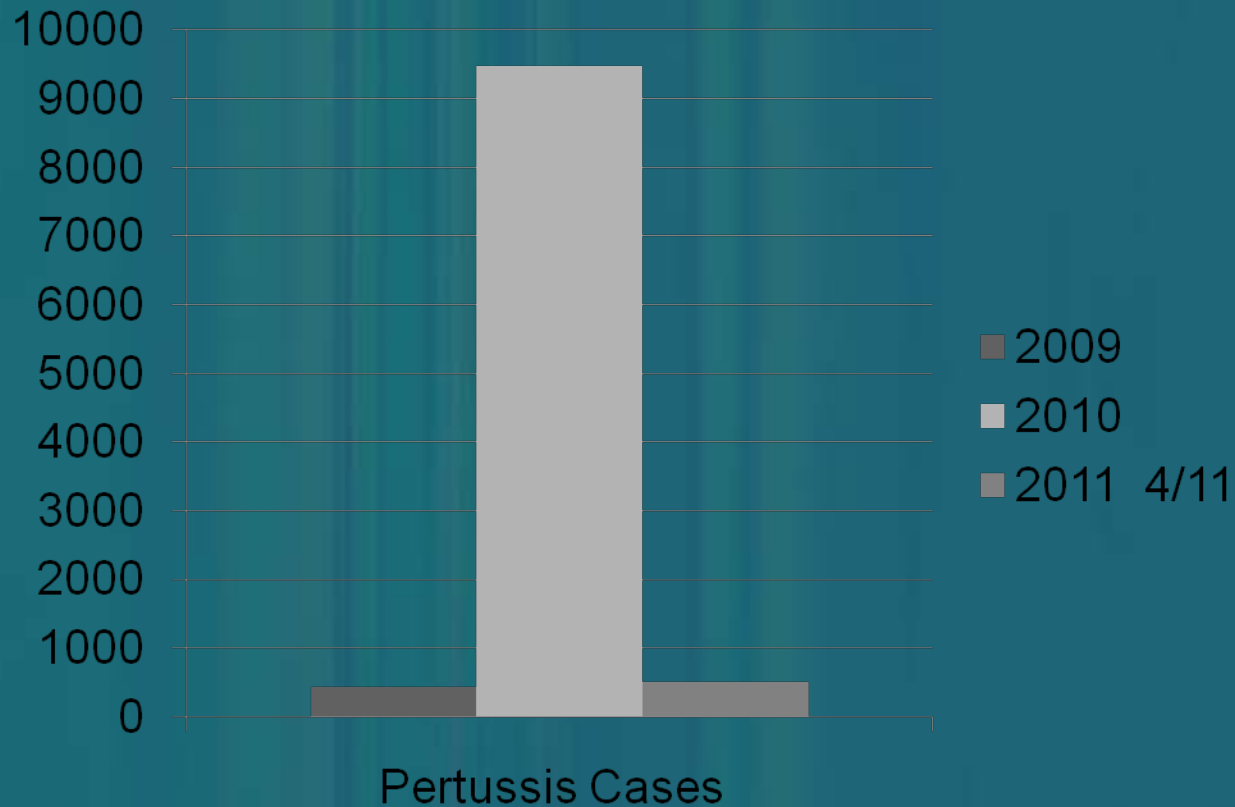
AZ Pertussis Statistics

The Cocooning Concept

The concept of cocooning is to protect a baby from getting pertussis by vaccinating those around him/her with Tdap vaccine

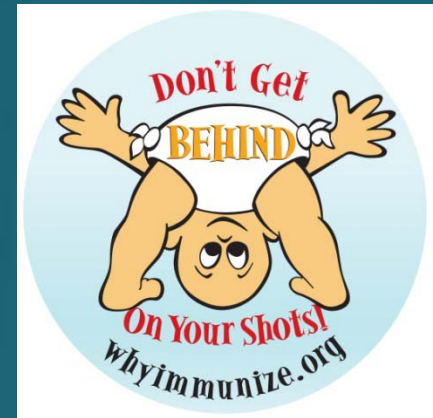
How We Got Started

Received a grant from Arizona Dept. of Public Health Services (ADHS).

Received another grant from BHHS Legacy Foundation to work with Community Health Centers

Why Cocooning

- DTaP Vaccine (diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis)
 - 5 shot series starting at 2 month - 5/6 years old
 - protection build with each shot
 - no vaccine is 100% effective
 - this protection fades with time



Why Cocooning



The Cocooning Project

- To partner with AZ hospitals to provide resources to employees & patients
- Pertussis flyers & posters
- Presentations about pertussis & cocooning
- Hospital forms to vaccinate patients and other caregivers
- Ongoing support

Tdap Vaccine

- This vaccine is for pre-teens, teens and adults of all ages
- Tdap is especially important for those that are caregivers to new infants and young children
- Currently Tdap is a one time booster

- Refer them to get immunized



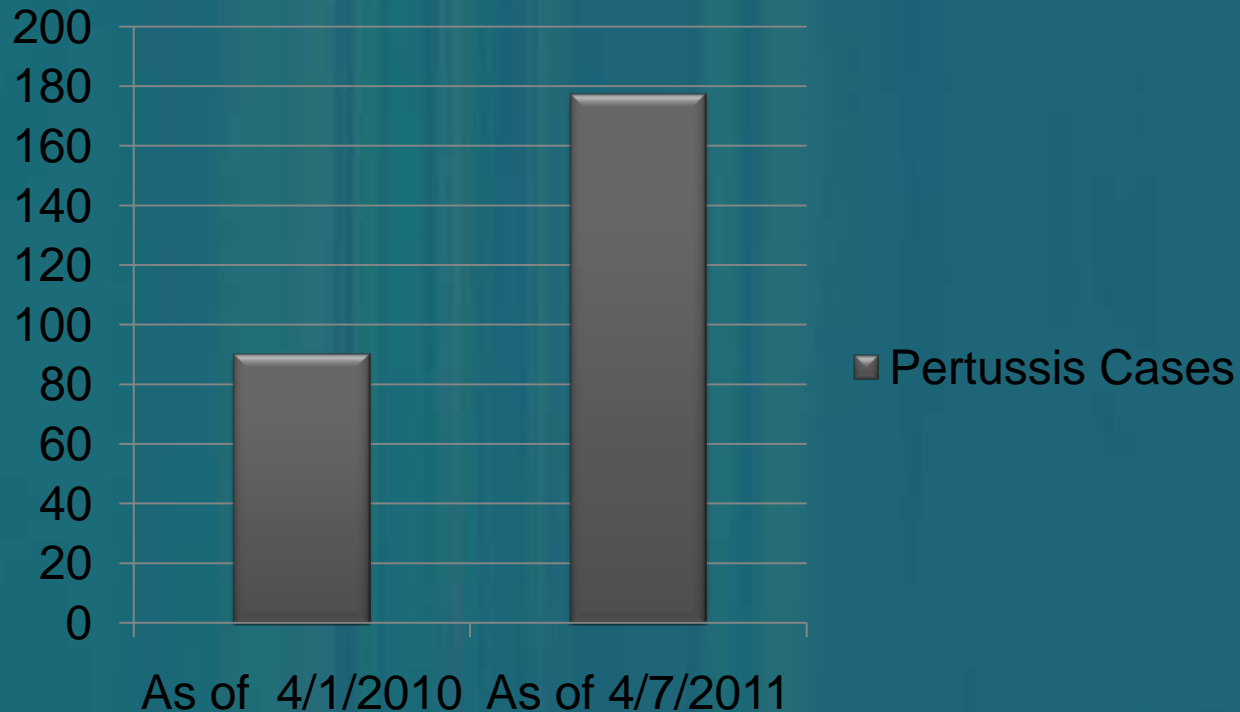
2010 Tdap Rates.....
